We had a great turnout of Southeastern Delta Zetas! Convention had its usual events - business meetings, a financial seminar, etc. But this time, there were several new events - Fun night was a great time with the different regions performing skits (and including alumnae) and poking fun at National President Debbie Raziano regarding pantyhose! The hotel cost is \$88 per night (including tax). You may have up to 4 in a room. So, that breaks down to:

\$22/night/person for 4 in room

\$29.34/night/person for 3 in room

\$44/night/person for 2 in room

Remember that these costs are per night, so if you are arriving on Friday and staying until Sunday, you will have 2 nights.
